Copper Mountain is excited to partner with The Summit Foundation and Colorado Mountain College to offer two scholarship opportunities for employees and dependents:

The Summit Foundation: Copper Mountain Resort Scholarship

- Two \$2000 scholarships available each year for graduating seniors from Summit High School or neighboring communities. Students must live/work or have a parent/guardian who lives/works at Copper Mountain Resort either presently or within the prior winter season
- All other Summit Foundation scholarship criteria will apply:
 - Minimum of 2.75 GPA unless extenuating circumstances
 - Student must be attending an accredited post-secondary educational institution
 - Scholarship funds may be used to support tuition, fees and on-campus room and board expenses only and will be paid directly to the educational institution

Colorado Mountain College: Copper Mountain Resort Scholarship

- Eligible applicants must be enrolled or planning to enroll in an Associate's degree program at the Lake, Eagle, or Summit Campus of Colorado Mountain College. Priority will be given to applicants pursuing a degree in Culinary Arts, Ski Area Operations, and/or with personal or family history in the ski industry. First year program recipients of the scholarship are eligible to apply for a renewed scholarship for year two (2), provided the student maintains a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- One award of up to \$1,190 per year.
- Application deadline: March 15 through Colorado Mountain College
