

Copper Mountain Employee Golf Benefits for the 2025 Season

Option #1: Buy an employee season pass for \$399

- This option is available to active summer employees and 24/25 winter employees in good standing.
- It is highly recommended for those who want to play once or more per week.
- You will be able to book tee times the day before play for afternoon timeslots and will be able to book online. No play before noon allowed on this pass.
- You can purchase it anytime at the golf shop with your current pass and summer sticker or verification from HR that you are an employee in good standing.
- You can bring up to 3 guests per day for \$40 per person playing on the same tee time as you.

Option #2: Booking tee times at the employee rate of \$20 per round

- This option is available to all active summer employees.
- Winter employees and volunteers are not eligible for this discount.
- \$20 for 9 or 18 holes.
- You can book your tee time the day before play for noon or later any day of the week. No play before noon on this discount.
- Tee times must be booked by calling the golf shop at 970-968-3333 and identifying yourself as an employee.
- You must check in and pay at the golf shop with your current employee pass with summer sticker.
- You can bring up to 3 guests per day at \$40 per person playing on the same tee time as you.

Option #3: 20% off of any rack rate round

- This option is for anyone looking to book a tee time further out than the day before or play golf earlier than noon.
- Must be booked by calling the golf shop at 970-968-3333 and identifying yourself as an employee.
- Must provide current employee pass with summer sticker at check in.

Golf Benefit Guidelines:

Employees using any employee golf benefit will be expected to follow the below guidelines, failure to do so may result in a loss of golf benefits.

- Treat the golf staff and all other golfers with respect
- Do not bring outside alcohol to or on the course
- No drug use on the course is allowed
- Do not show up (or become while playing) obviously intoxicated or impaired
- Keep a reasonable Pace of Play, no more than 4 golfers per group is allowed
- Respect the golf course, do not intentionally damage things
- Follow all normal golf etiquette
- Any golf cart damage is your responsibility (you will be charged)
- All players must have their own set of clubs
- Rental clubs are not included; you must pay for them
- Dress in proper golf attire; collared shirt preferred; you will be denied play if not dressed appropriately
