

## Reciprocal Privileges - 2023/2024 Season

All active employees/volunteers in good standing with POWDR Resorts are eligible for the following benefits:

- Winter - Paid employees (full time, 10/11 month & seasonal) and eligible dependents (spouse, cohabiting partner as defined as an eligible dependent at the "host" resort, and dependent children) - free lift/access ticket.
- Winter - Active volunteers\* Three free days; lift/access after the three free days will be 50% off current window price.
- Winter - Powderbird 10% off heli-ski (\$160 discount), or site seeing tours per person per day.
- Summer – Employees/volunteers will receive the same privileges that the employees/volunteers at the resort that they are visiting receive (If home employees receive free golf, then the same privileges will be extended to visiting employees.)

\*Eligible volunteers must present this POWDR Reciprocal Privileges Letter and a valid 2023/2024 Volunteer season pass to receive the three (3) free days as well as the 50% discounted ticket, 10% discounted heli-ski or site seeing tours.

A valid 2023/2024 winter season pass (or state ID/license -Woodward/POWDR only) showing either the employee, dependent(s), or volunteer status on the pass must be presented along with a **POWDR Reciprocal Privileges Letter**. Participants must present one letter for each day that they will be participating in skiing/activities at the reciprocal resort (i.e. if you are planning on skiing 2 days, you will need 2 letters). The letters will be surrendered to the visiting resort's ticket window.

### Process:

- Employee/volunteer contacts their home resort HR department with the resort that they are planning on visiting and the dates, as well as the names of any dependents that will be joining them. Letters may be requested within 2 weeks of travel dates.
- Employee/volunteer may be responsible for reserving a parking space. Contact the resort for reservation requirements.
- The home HR department will produce letters for each day of skiing/riding/activities.
- The participant will present the letters to the visiting resort's ticket window to exchange for a lift ticket/activities.

### General Information:

- This program is valid for the following locations: Boreal Ridge, Eldora Mountain Resort, Killington Mountain Resort, Mt. Bachelor, Pico Mountain Resort, Copper Mountain Resort, Soda Springs, Snowbird Resort, SilverStar and Woodward Park City.
- NOTE: Woodward Camp/POWDR employees must be full-time year round in order to be eligible to participate in this program.
- Employee/volunteer must be in good standing and have a valid 23/24 season pass (State ID or DL for Woodward).
- Both the POWDR Reciprocal Skiing Privileges Letter and pass must be presented to receive privileges.
- Dependents do not need to be accompanied by an employee when redeeming the letter for a pass at the ticket window.
- Blackout periods may apply. We ask for consideration during peak periods such as holidays or special events.
- This program is discretionary and subject to change at any time without notice.
